Dear Cookie Stroll Bakers,

Oct. 18, 2023

Planning for the 11th annual Martinsville Cookie Stroll is underway. If you would like to participate as an official Cookie Stroll Baker, please fully complete and submit this application by **midnight on Friday, Nov 10th**. We appreciate each one of you who participates in this community tradition that builds the Main Street area!

The Cookie Stroll will be December 9th, from 10 a.m. - 5 p.m. This gives businesses all day as a cookie stop and gives consumers all day to shop in their stores. In order to keep the stroll to an all day event and still meet the increased demand for vouchers, we will require 24 dozen cookies per stop. However, we are limiting the amount of stops to 26 stops. This allows us to keep roughly the same amount of bakers as previous years.

This year, we will need approximately 76 cookie bakers who will each bake and donate 8 dozen cookies. Each cookie stop will have three bakers for a total of 24 dozen cookies per stop. This equates to a grand total of at least 7,488 cookies! Please reach out to fellow employees, family members, and friends to help us find bakers for the business establishments who will be our Cookie Stops this year. **Each baker baking 8 doz. cookies can receive a complimentary Cookie Stroll passport, just make sure to indicate that you want your passport on the application.**

All Cookie Stroll bakers get a free entry into the **Holiday Cookie Baking Contest**, which will be held December 7th, 2022 at 7 pm, at the The Source: 75 E. Washington St. Martinsville, IN. 46151. Cash prizes are available. This contest is also open to the public for a \$2.00 entry fee. We will send out more information on this in another email.

As in the previous year, the cookie recipes will be available in a pdf version cook book that can be accessed on Rediscover Martinsville's Website, www.rediscovermartinsville.org. This method allows Cookie Stroll participants to know ingredients and be able to bake their favorite cookies from the Cookie Stroll at home. Please make sure to submit your recipe title and recipe with the Baker Application. If you have a pdf typed version email Laura Elliott.

Due to Covid Concerns, Bakers should be fever and symptom free in order to bake. If you or someone residing in your home has Covid or Covid symptoms, please find someone else to cover for you or call us.

To be considered as a Cookie Stroll Baker, please fill out and submit the attached application as soon as possible—but certainly before the deadline of midnight on Friday, Nov. 10th. Return it by emailing the completed form to the below email address or mailing it to Rediscover Martinsville at the address indicated on the baker application Please put "CS Baker Ap" on your envelope.
